How do we accomplish it?

We provide a free, faith-based, confidential place for men ages 18 and above to build trust, be heard, and heal. The Adam Center is intentionally designed to create an environment where non-judgmental listening, sharing, encouragements and prayer support take place.

This is accomplished through:

1. Peer counseling: one on one sessions with a trained volunteer peer counselor
2. Study Groups on topics impacting men. Bible study and book study groups.
3. Resource Center: men may participate in a lending library program.
